

THE PLAN



Travel March 11-15, 2025 (Tuesday – Saturday)

Bus: Holds 53 (accounting for one wheelchair)

- 2 Directors (Mr. Dills and Ms. Stanley)
- 2 Caregivers: Some students traveling require caregivers who are 1:1 and do not count as chaperones
- 6 chaperones (must be 21 or older, 25 or older is preferred)
- 43 students

Additional students and chaperones will be placed on a waitlist to see if we have enough interest to procure a second bus without increasing per person costs. The hope is to make the trip happen for all who sign up!

Numbers may change depending on who chooses to travel. All plans are based on including ALL students so accommodate for possible needs.

Note: We do not have a clear make/break number as there are too many variables. We will assess as registrations come in and will do EVERYTHING we can to make this trip a success!



CHAPERONES / ADULTS



Dedicated Chaperones

- CCS required ratio 1:10
- Goal ratio 1:6 (does not include directors or caregivers)
- Pay chaperone cost of \$1800
- Two adults to a hotel room
- Can pay the difference of ~\$550 to secure a single room (also applies to directors)
- Must be 21 or older / 25+ preferred
- Must complete a CCS Volunteer check
- Same meals as students are now included

Other Adults

- **Directors** will be assigned to a chaperone group as a second adult so that they are free to deal with emergencies, discipline, etc.
- **Caregivers** will be a second adult in the group their student is assigned to and can assist the chaperone, but their primary responsibility is to their individual student. They will be assigned to a room with their student. Same cost as chaperones.
- ABCD Adventures (Ms. Garcia) will be in NYC to be a liaison with the vendors but *will not* interact with students. She is traveling at her own expense (covered by her fee).

Radio City Music Hall or Carnegie Hall Tour



INDIVIDUAL CANCELATION POLICY

Note: Final payment is due 1/15/25, so we are currently in the 179 - 121 day timeframe

Cancellation Notice:

Cancellations will only be accepted from the participant or their legal guardian, and must be verified by the Group Leader/Director. A written notice is required to process cancellations, and the cancellation date is determined by the date Jay M Robinson Performance Ensembles receives your written notice. Non-payment of installment payments may also be considered a cancellation by the participant.

Cancellation Fees:

- 180 days or more before final payment: Non-refundable deposit will be forfeited.
- 179 to 121 days before final payment: Non-refundable deposit and a \$75.00 cancellation fee will be forfeited.
- 120 to 61 days before final payment: 50% of the trip price will be forfeited.
- 60 days or less before final payment: No refund; all payments will be forfeited.

Note: Non-payment of installment payments may be considered a cancellation by the participant.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

- Optional, but recommended
- Purchased by you (not included)
- Coverage varies but it protects your investment if you are not able to travel
